This will be the first major Train Show and Sales in the Rochester, Buffalo, and Syracuse area since early 2020. We believe it is an excellent opportunity for you to participate, be involved, and sell your model train/toy supplies to the public. We would like you to come join our show as a vendor.

Show dates and hours are: Saturday September 11th from 10 AM - 5 PM Sunday September 12th from 10 AM - 4 PM

An on-site food vendor will be available at the show.

Vendor Setup:

Friday September 10th from 3:00 PM to 8:00 PM Saturday September 11th from 7:30 AM to 9:30 AM Teardown will start at 4:00 PM on Sunday, September 12th

Vendor Tables:

- Up to 100 tables available on a first come/first serve basis.
- Cost \$40.00/table (8' x 30"); electric extra (\$10.00).
- One chair per table is available if needed.
- Table covering is not provided.
- Vendor passes to be requested in advance with names and available at check-in.
- A preliminary floor plan will be available by request
- Table requests are not confirmed until signed vendor contract and payment is received.

Information about FCTT HiRailers Train Club:

The FCTT HiRailers is a modular Hi-Rail Model Train Club based in Rochester New York. We have been in existence for over 30 years and are a non-profit 501c3 organization. We operate and display O-Gauge model trains from various manufacturers at train shows and community events, averaging about 14 train shows per year. FCTT is nationally recognized as a premier O-Gauge Hi-Rail Model Railroad Club. Our expertise is putting up and operating high-quality train layout displays at multiple venues throughout the year for the public to enjoy including at train shows, county fairs, senior living homes, Children's Hospital, Senior Fund Raisers, Libraries, and national venues. We have displayed at the TCA National Convention in Burlington, VT, the LOTS National Convention in Saratoga Springs, NY, the TTOS National Convention in Buffalo, NY, and three times at the TCA Eastern Division show in York, PA. In addition, FCTT hosted the 2012 LOTS National Convention in Rochester, NY.

We are celebrating our belated 30th year anniversary at the FCTT Hemlock Train Show. FCTT will be assembling and displaying our largest and most detailed layout that we have constructed in the past 10 years at this train show.

We have developed an aggressive advertising plan for the Hemlock Train Show. Fourteen train clubs are being notified of our plan and we are promoting the show at the Hemlock Fairgrounds where we are a major attraction with anticipated attendance of 30,000+ people. We also have plans to advertise the train show at the New York State Fair in Syracuse, NY.

We are confident it will be a crowd pleaser and encourage involvement in our favorite hobby - Model Railroading!

Information on Hemlock Fairgrounds:

The FCTT HiRailers Hemlock Train Show will be held at the Hemlock Fairgrounds, 7370 Water St, Hemlock, NY 14466 in the 14,300+ square foot Ag Expo Building. This is a secure building with ample parking for vendors and the public.

Hemlock Fairgrounds is located just 20 miles south of Rochester, NY and within a 100 mile radius of Buffalo, Syracuse, Corning, Hamburg, and Hornell, on the north end of Hemlock Lake, at the intersection of routes NY 20A and NY 15A.

Accommodations are available at several hotels nearby in the I-390, I-90 corridor. There are also RV sites available on-site at the Hemlock Fairgrounds; cost is \$25.00/night and includes water and electric.
